## **WOLDSWAY RUN**

### **9th May 2010**

We are now in the fifteenth year of this popular and successful touring event, and once again we have a **new and interesting route**. We are inviting entries from all makes of classic and sport cars, as well as M.G.s.

Due to the overwhelming response to this event, for which we have averaged entries of 100 cars ranging from such rare classics as a 1961 VW Karmann Ghia, several XK Series Jaguars, as well as M.G.s. of all ages, from a 1930 M Type to the latest M.G.TF, your early application is advised to avoid disappointment.

Due to the limited places there will be no entries accepted on the day, so on this note please make sure all application forms are returned promptly.

This year cars will leave at **9.30 a.m.** starting from the Humber Bridge North Car Park where refreshments will be available for purchase before departure. Here you will be issued with your numbered rally plate and your Tulip Rally style road book.

As in previous years optional refreshment stops along the way will include the Ramblers Tea Rooms or alternatively the Gate Inn both located in the beautiful village of Millington and a lunch time halt at Sledmere House, one of Yorkshire's premier stately homes, the Tea shop provides a range of light meals. You can however, if you prefer, enjoy a picnic here.

The route takes us finally to Sewerby Hall near Bridlington where the cars will be displayed in a reserved parking area on the lawns. Sewerby Hall houses the Museum of East Yorkshire and has a range of craft shops, a walled rose garden and 50 acres of wooded parkland. If you need refreshments after your journey, the Clock Tower Tea Rooms will provide a pleasant repast. Admission to Sewerby Hall is included in the £15.00 per car entry fee.

Once again the event will be supporting the charity **Yorkshire Cancer Research** and as before a presentation will be made on the day.

Entry to the event is open to *all M.G.s. of any age, plus any classic or sports car*. If you have entered the event before, we promise you the same high standard of organisation, if it's your first time, then we look forward to meeting you. **Please** do not embarrass the organisers by attending in a non-qualifying car.

Signing on for the run will be 8.30 a.m. – 9.10 a.m. Cars will be displayed prior to departure at 9.30 a.m. with plenty of opportunity to meet fellow enthusiasts. There will be plenty of time to complete the route, though crews should aim to arrive at Sewerby by 3.00 p.m. At 4.00 p.m. the cheque will be presented to **Yorkshire Cancer Research**.
